





Instructions

- 1. Print out the pages on white printer paper or card stock.
- 2. Color the ornaments as desired.
- 3. Cut out the ornaments.
- 4. Crease on all of the solid lines.
- 5. Cut out a piece of yarn about 8 inches in length.
- 6. Tie a double knot at one end of the piece of yarn.
- 7. Tie a loop for hanging at the other end of the yarn.
- 8. Fold the ornament to determine where the top is.
- 9. Glue the knot to the inside of the ornament near the top. Leave the rest of the yarn (including the loop) hanging out of the top.
- 10. Fold the ornament and glue the tabs. Hold the glued tabs a few seconds.
- 11. When the ornament is completely dry, hang it up.

Alternatively, you can use string in place of yarn to hang the ornament. Simply thread some heavy string through a needle and poke the needle through the top of the ornament. Tie a loop and hang.
