Introduction

Thank you for downloading this puzzle pack. I hope that it brings your child many hours of enjoyment!

The first three puzzles were designed to be used in a variety of ways.

- The full-color puzzles can be used alone. Simply print off the puzzles on white printer paper or card stock, laminate the pages, and cut out the puzzle pieces.
- The puzzles can be assembled on top of the grayscale images. The grayscale pictures act as an added visual cue for the child. Print off the puzzles and grayscale images on white printer paper or card stock, laminate the pages, and cut out the full-color puzzle pieces.
- The puzzles and grayscale images can be used as a cut-and-paste activity. Print off the puzzles and grayscale pictures on white printer paper. Have the child cut out the full-color puzzle pieces and paste them on the grayscale page.

The last page in this download has a Raggedy Andy number puzzle. This can be use to help your child learn numbers 1 through 10.

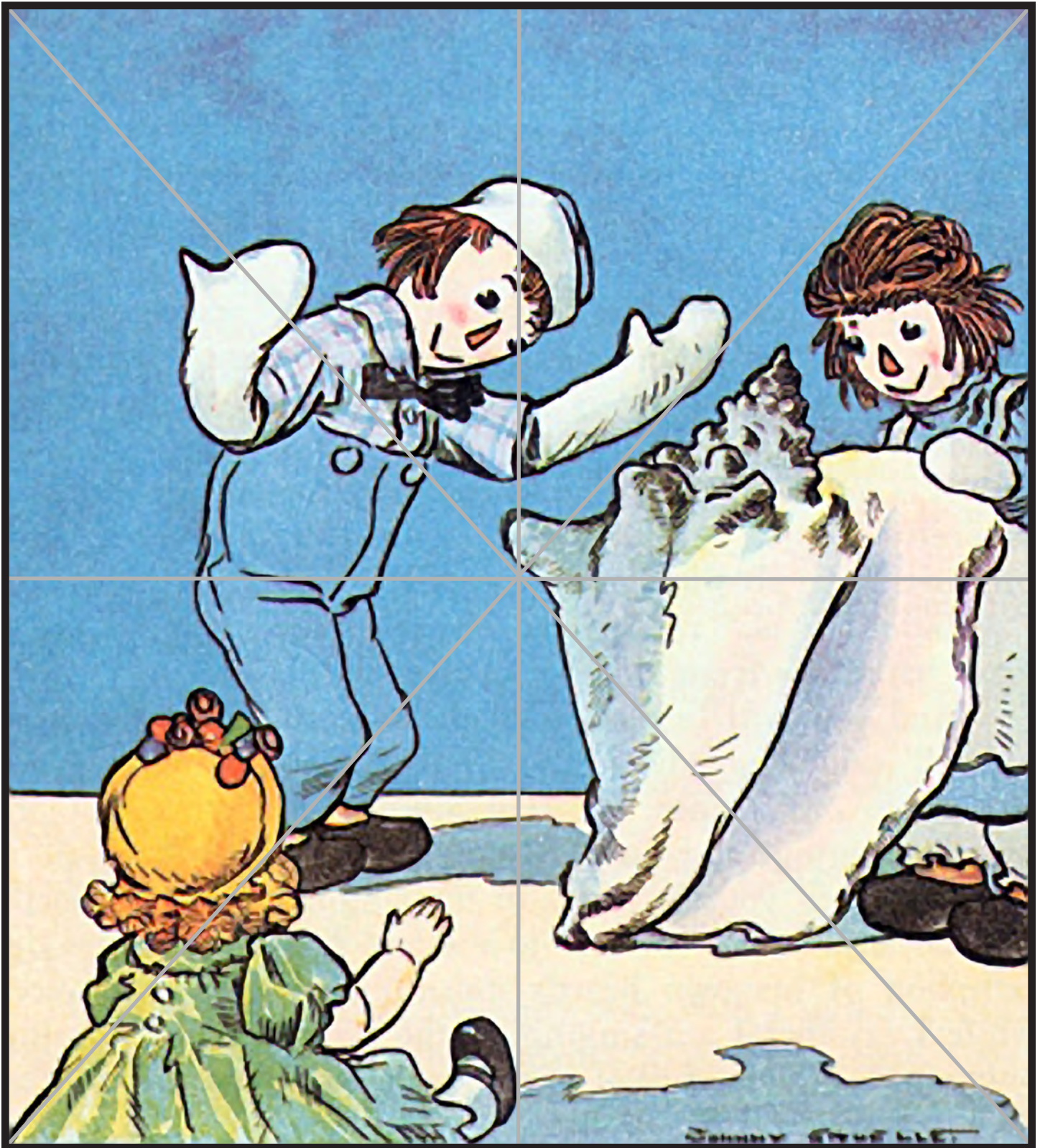

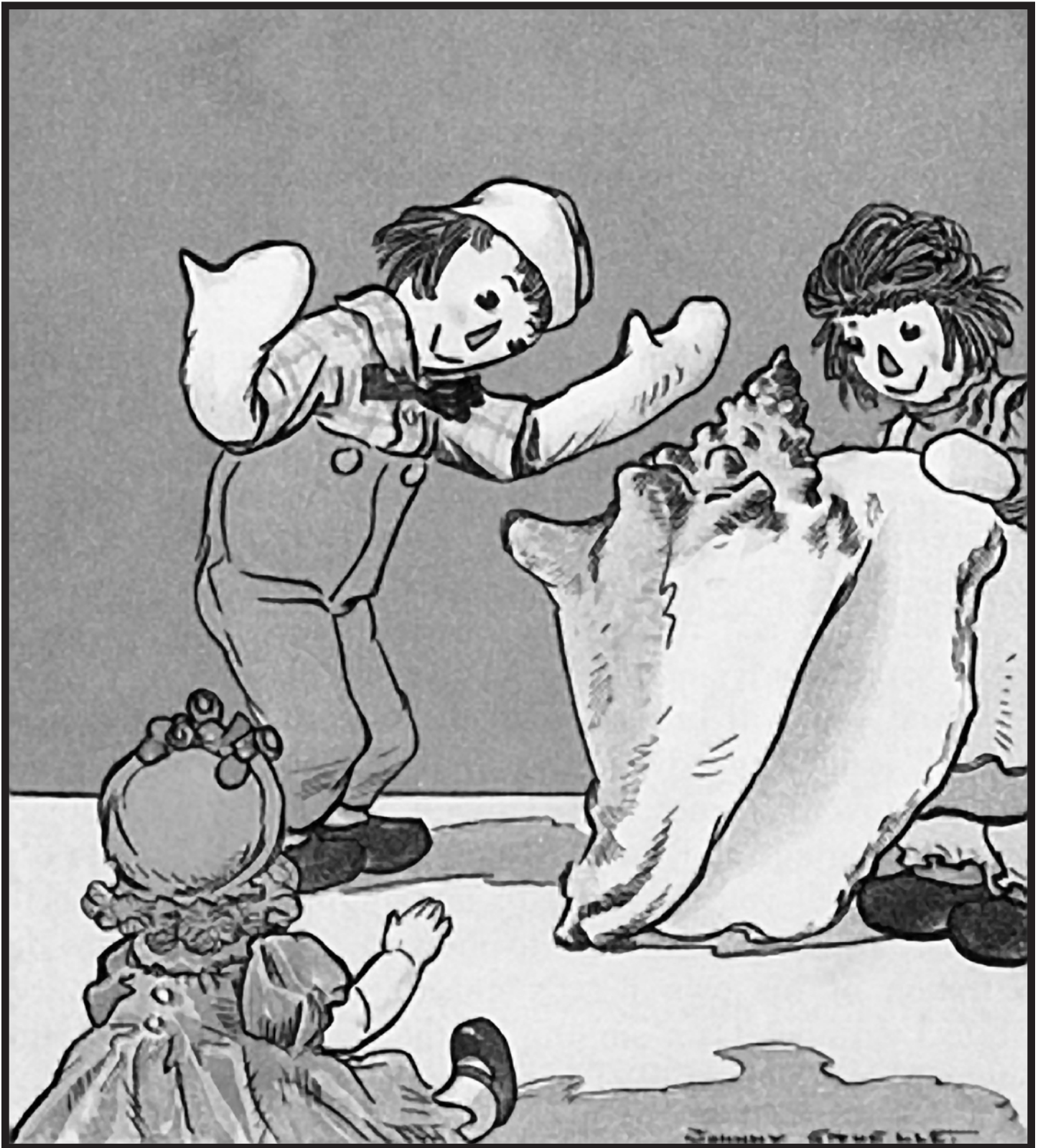
