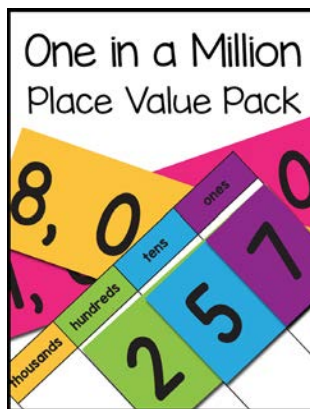
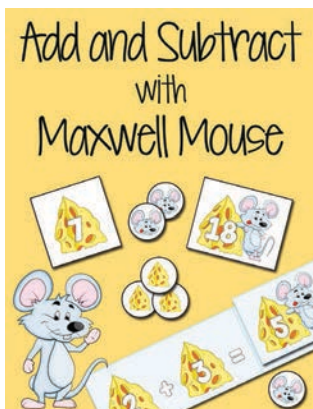
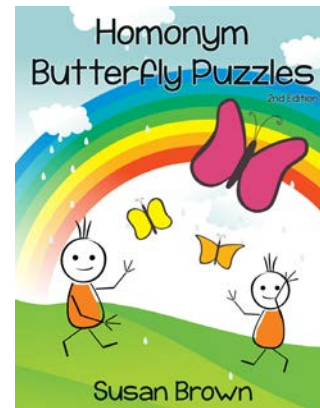

This pack is made up of a set of printable sheets that have over 200 words for the word "said."

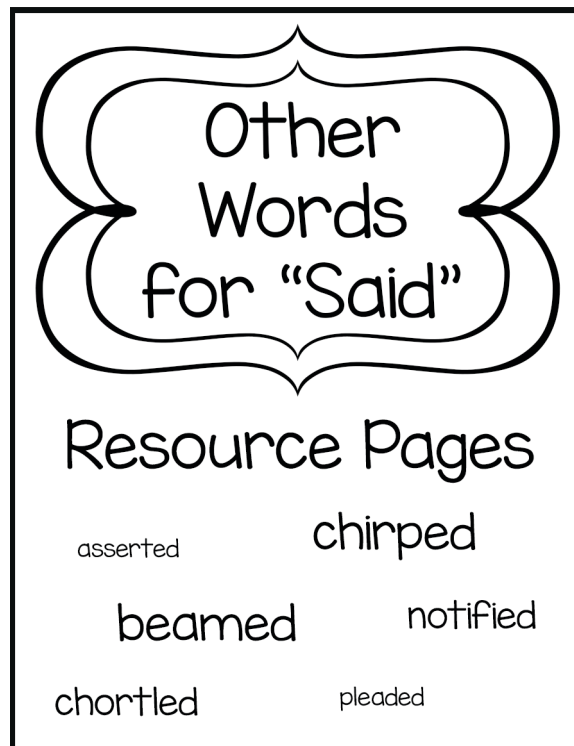
These words have been divided into three categories in order to make it easier for your children to choose words.
